

Escalator Safety Tips

for escalator passengers

Below are basic safety tips to ensure that your escalator usage is safe and comfortable.

Do not press the toes or heels of footwear made of soft materials such as rubber or vinyl into the gaps of the skirt-guard panel or the steps.

If foreign objects get caught between the skirt-guard panel and the steps, it may cause an accident.
In addition, the safety device may activate and bring the machine to an abrupt stop, which could lead to falls.



Do not carry large luggage on the escalator.

This may cause accidents, such as falling together with your luggage or your fallen luggage striking other users.



Do not ride while wearing long skirts or clothes that drag on the ground.

Your clothes may get caught and you could fall.



Hold onto the handrail.

Hold the moving handrail to avoid falling or slipping.



No wheelchairs, strollers, or shopping carts.

This may lead to falling or equipment failure



Stand inside the yellow line.

Placing your foot on the yellow line may cause your foot to be caught.
